

The Rotary Club of Yakima and the Yakima Rotary Charities 2019 Academic Scholarship Application

Note: 19 Scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each will be awarded this year.

The Rotary Club of Yakima is a club created to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster, high ethical standards; the application of service in one's personal, business, and community life; and the advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through individuals united in the idea of service.

Rotarians live by the 4-Way Test. They ask:

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?**
 - 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?**
 - 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?**
 - 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?**
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Academic Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

1. The scholarship is to be used at a post-high school institution beginning in the fall after graduation from high school. The award will be sent directly to the student's college or university upon proof of actual full-time enrollment.
2. Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - Academic performance;
 - Community service and leadership exhibited within the school environment;
 - Community service and leadership exhibited outside of the school environment;
 - Student essay concerning the importance of community service and leadership, how they have exhibited community service and leadership in their lives, and how those concepts can be used to improve the quality of life in our communities.
 - Two letters of recommendations.
 - Financial need.

Scholarships will be awarded to students who exhibit outstanding academic performance and community service, both within the school environment and outside of the community environment, with consideration also given to need.

Instructions for Completing and Submitting the Application:

1. Fully complete and submit the attached application and required essay.
2. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation as follows:
 - a. One letter from a school teacher, counselor or administrator
 - b. One letter from a community member
3. Submit a transcript of grades (including a GPA) as well as SAT or ACT scores. **A school official must sign this section as verification of the accuracy of the information provided.**
4. FASFA or WASFA Student Aid Report showing your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)

* Finalists will be **notified** the week of **April 15, 2019** and will be asked to attend a *personal interview* (5-7 minutes in length) with the Academic Scholarship Committee tentatively set for April 22nd or April 24th.

Deadline for Submission: Applications **MUST BE POSTMARKED** by Friday, March 8, 2019.
